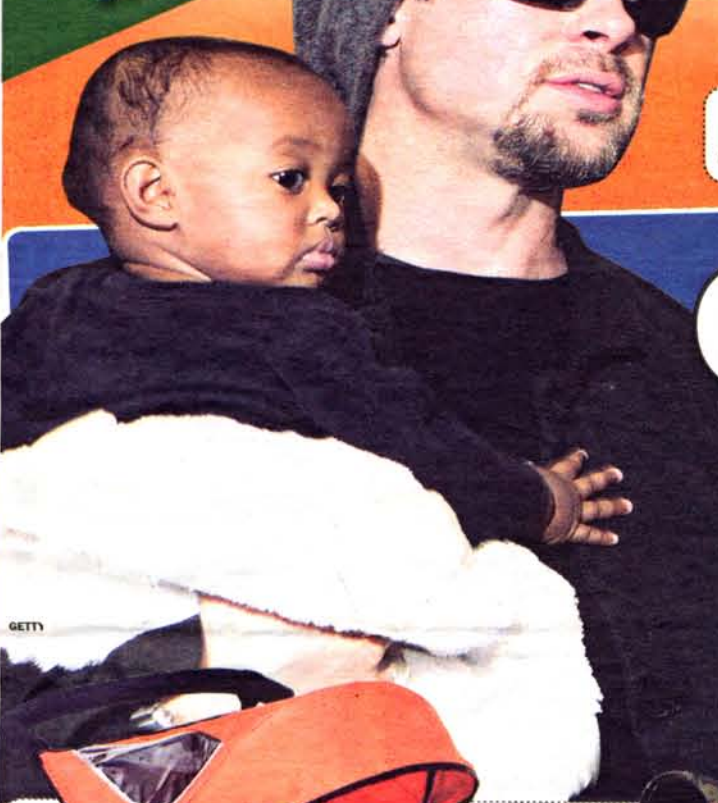


GREAT GIFT IDEAS FOR FATHER'S DAY JUNE 18!
